To the UK and Back

What a trip we had! We are grateful to the Lord for His watch care over us in all our traveling about (plane, car, train, Tube, foot...), and also for blessing us with wonderful times of fellowship with friends and family.

We spent our first week in Manchester, where we stayed with the leaders of the GFA-UK international office and served with them during the work week. The office there is smaller than the US office, with about 6 full or part-time staff members, and another 5 or 6 volunteers who come in various days of the week. Their work is similar to ours, just for a different country: gift entry, communications to donors and sponsors, correspondence with the field, connecting with churches, maintaining website content,

sending emails... They don't have an IT

department, so our goal during the week was to

help them with some of their IT needs. We worked on over 10 projects for them, ranging from a very small data tweak to a multi-hour task to fix one of their import processes. The biggest project Rob worked on was a full audit of their system, learning about their current database structure and regular procedures. It's possible that we will migrate their database into StudioEnterprise (SE) within the next year or two, and having a comprehensive understanding of their current system will make the project more streamlined on all fronts. We also demoed SE for them, which made them very excited!

We didn't just work in the office, though. Just like at our US



office, the UK staff spend several hours together in prayer. We were delighted to join them for their late -night prayer meeting on the Friday we arrived, as well as the

It was a blessing to get to know them personally, rather than just seeing their faces in pictures or working with them over emails.
