

Acquiring the Fire

Even while I was at home for Christmas break, I had the opportunity to work with Gospel for Asia. I helped man GFA's table at OneFest.

a 24-hour Christian music festival on December 28-29. Of all the places in America it could have taken place, it was in Cedar Falls, Iowa, only an hour from my home! I joined Mike Johnson, a GFA volunteer, and we handed out GFA's free book Revolution in World Missions and told people about GFA's child sponsorship program, Bridge of Hope. I told people, "This book is awesome! You need to read it! This book has had a greater impact on my life than any other book I have ever read!" (Get YOUR free book at www.gfa.org!) The music was sometimes so loud I had to shout at people a foot away from me, but the event was still a huge success for us. We distributed over 500 books, and had more than 30 kids sponsored! Mike and I were both amazed at the favor God granted us.

On January 27-28, four other GFA staff and I drove down to Houston for the youth rally Acquire the Fire. We stood in front of our table, intercepting people with "Have you heard about Bridge of Hope?" Ours was a life-anddeath mission. We described to people the horrible plight of the "untouchables" in India: No rights, treated like slaves. Average income of less than \$40 per year. Up to 95% illiteracy in places. Possibly 100 million child laborers. We explained what Bridge of Hope offers: an education, school uniforms, a good meal each day, medical care, and most importantly the love and hope of Jesus Christ. Most of the kids give their lives to Jesus, and often GFA is able to plant a church within months. It was awesome to see people's response to this message. I was hoping for 20 children to be sponsored, but we had a whopping 55 sponsored! As one person said, "Thank you so much for stopping me to tell me about Bridge of Hope!"

At both OneFest and Acquire the Fire, God clearly gave us favor with people. At OneFest, we had forgotten to request electricity, so the coordinator moved us to a better location and gave us electricity for free. At ATF, we also had a bad table location but we were able to move to a great spot.

Both times, we were amazed at people's response—clearly God was moving them. At both events, we prayed together many times as a group. What a blessing it was to see God answer our prayers!

I think I have discovered my passion. I was talking with Heather at ATF during one of the breaks, and I explained to her what a mathematical game is and showed her how to win the game of Nim. Then I showed her some other math stuff I was fascinated by. Suddenly I realized that although I love math, I love sharing about Gospel for Asia far more. I love being a part of bringing hope and eternal life to the perishing. That is what I am passionate about.
